Don't be a hero and muscle through this installation without reading these fitting instructions first! Improper installation of this gear may void certain aspects of your warranty.

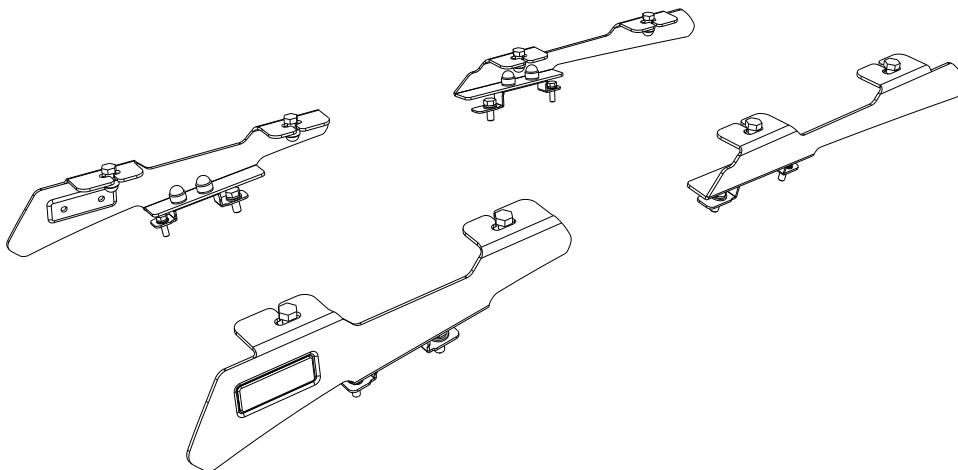
Before you begin, take a moment and open all your Front Runner rack kit boxes and gather the assembly instructions for the various components.

A complete kit will contain:

1. A Front Runner Mounting System specific to your vehicle
2. A Front Runner Rack Tray or Load Bar Slats

This document will guide you through the assembly of the mounting system and assist you in fitting the roof rack tray or load bars to your specific vehicle.

5	12 X	M8 x 20 Hex Bolt
6	4 X	M6 x 20 Hex Bolt
7	4 X	M6 SS Spring Washer
8	4 X	M6 x 12 x 1 SS Flat Washer
9	20 X	M8 x 16 x 1.6 SS Flat Washer
10	16 X	M8 Nyloc Nut
11	16 X	M8 Nut Cap
12	4 X	M8 SS Spring Washer

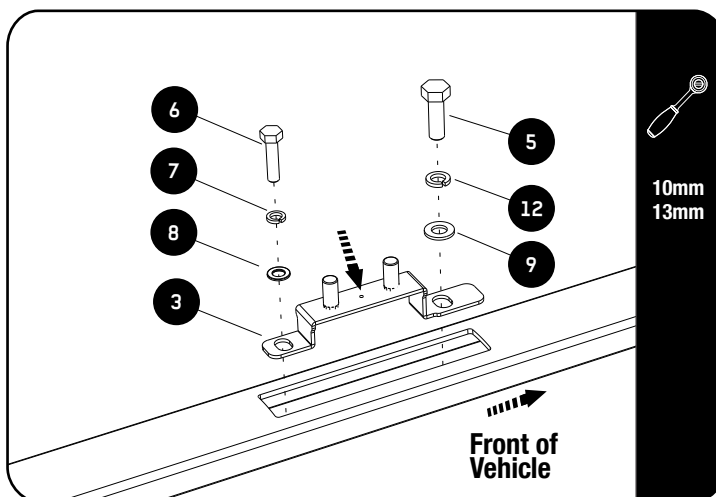


Before starting the fitment you need to remove the front and rear rail covers from the vehicle's roof rails using a flat screw driver.

Loosen the M6 factory bolt shown in 2.1. This will be replaced with the fasteners in 2.2 & 2.3.

Do this with all four pockets.

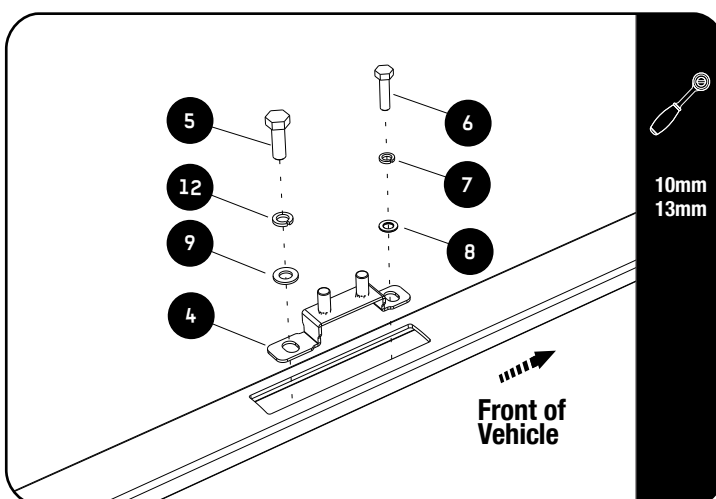

Secure the Rear Saddle Bracket (Item 3) to the vehicle using M8 x 20 Hex Bolts, M8 SS Spring Washers and M8 x 16 x 1.6 SS Flat Washers (Items 5, 9 & 12) into the front mounting hole and M6 x 20 Hex Bolts, M6 SS Flat Washers and M6 x 12 x 1 SS Flat Washers (Items 6, 7 & 8) into the rear mounting hole as shown.

Repeat this on both sides of the vehicle.

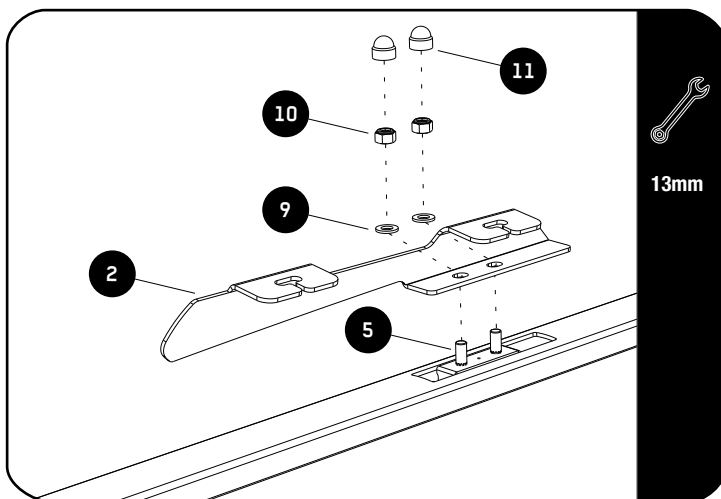

Secure the Front Saddle Bracket (Item 4) to the vehicle using M6 x 20 Hex Bolts, M6 SS Flat Washers and M6 x 12 x 1 SS Flat Washers (Items 6, 7 & 8) into the front mounting hole and M8 x 20 Hex Bolts, M8 SS Spring Washers and M8 x 16 x 1.6 SS Flat Washers (Items 5, 9 & 12) into the rear mounting hole as shown.

Repeat this on both sides of the vehicle.

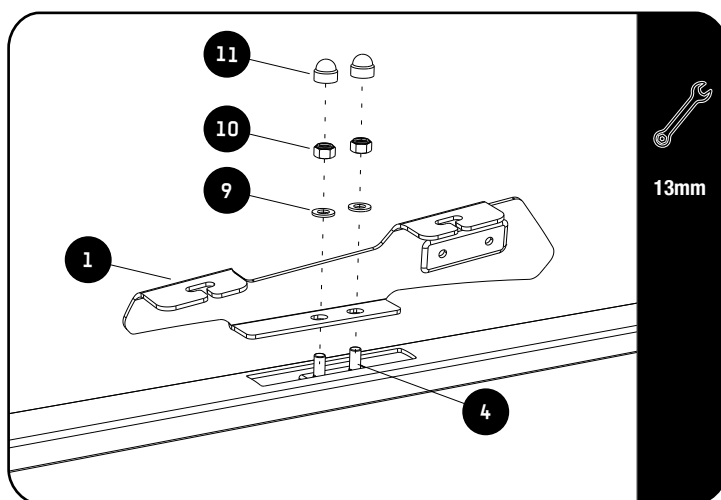


Secure the Rear Foot Rail (Item 2) to the Rear Saddle Bracket (Item 3) using M8 Nyloc Nut and M8 x 16 x 1.6 SS Flat Washers (Items 9 & 10) as shown.

Finish off by placing M8 Nut Caps (Item 11) on the bolt heads.

Repeat this on both sides of the vehicle.

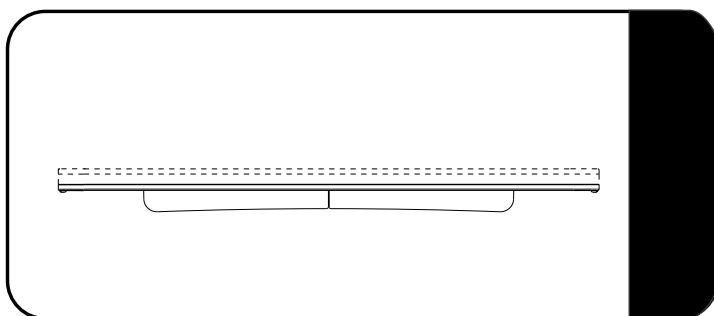


Secure the Front Foot Rail (Item 1) to the Front Saddle Bracket (Item 4) using M8 Nyloc Nut and M8 x 16 x 1.6 SS Flat Washers (Items 9 & 10) as shown.

Finish off by placing M8 Nut Caps (Item 11) on the bolt heads.

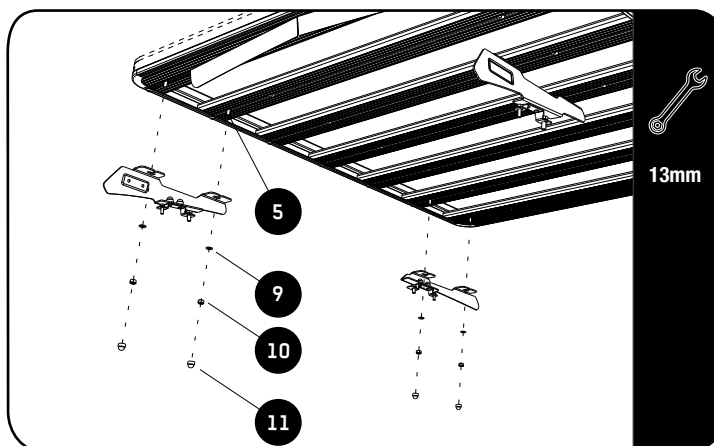
Repeat this on both sides of the vehicle.

Make sure that the wind deflector is installed before you proceed to the next step.

Fit your roof rack to the Foot Rails using M8 x 20 Hex Bolts, M8 x 16 x 1.6SS Flat Washers and M8 Nyloc Nuts (Items 5, 9 & 10) as shown.

Center the rack and tighten fully. Use M8 Nut Caps (Item 11) to finish off the nuts.
